Through Rockford, IL

Purpose: To unite the community in prayer, seeking spiritual renewal and transformation.

8. Roscoe Main Street (Roscoe, IL)

Landmark: Main Street, Roscoe

Scripture: Jeremiah 29:7 - "Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper."

Prayer Focus: Pray for community prosperity, strong local businesses, and the overall welfare of the residents.

9. Stateline Family YMCA (Beloit, WI)

Landmark: Stateline Family YMCA

Scripture: 1 Timothy 4:8 - "For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come."

Prayer Focus: Pray for health, fitness, and holistic well-being of the community members. Pray for programs that promote physical and spiritual health.

10. Beckman Mill County Park (Beloit, WI)

Landmark: Beckman Mill County Park

Scripture: Psalm 104:24 - "How many are your works, Lord! In wisdom you made them all; the earth is full of your creatures."

Prayer Focus: Conclude with prayers of gratitude for God's creation, and for wisdom in taking care of the environment. Pray for the community to come together in appreciation of nature's beauty.

Conclusion:

Closing prayer of thanksgiving and commitment to continue praying for the State-line area.



Through Rockford, IL (Alternative Route)

Purpose: To unite the community in prayer, seeking spiritual renewal and transformation.

Opening prayer: ask for guidance, protection, and open hearts.

1. Starting Point: Rockford Art Museum

Landmark: Rockford Art Museum

Scripture: Exodus 35:35 - "He has filled them with skill to do all kinds of work as engravers, designers, embroiderers in blue, purple and scarlet yarn and fine linen, and weavers—all of them skilled workers and designers."

Prayer Focus: Praise for creativity and the expression of beauty through art. Pray for artists and the cultural enrichment of the community.

2. Burpee Museum of Natural History

Landmark: Burpee Museum of Natural History

Scripture: Job 12:7-10 - "But ask the animals, and they will teach you, or the birds in the sky, and they will tell you; or speak to the earth, and it will teach you, or let the fish in the sea inform you."

Prayer Focus: Pray for a deeper understanding and respect for God's creation, and for educational institutions that foster this knowledge.

3. Tinker Swiss Cottage Museum & Gardens

Landmark: Tinker Swiss Cottage Museum & Gardens

Scripture: Proverbs 24:3-4 - "By wisdom a house is built, and through understanding it is established; through knowledge its rooms are filled with rare and beautiful treasures."

Prayer Focus: Pray for the preservation of history and heritage, and for the families and homes within the community.

Landmark: CherryVale Mall

Scripture: Matthew 6:31-33 - "So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them."

Prayer Focus: Pray for businesses, economic growth, and the provision of needs for all residents.

5. Rockford Police Department

Landmark: Rockford Police Department

Scripture: Romans 13:1 - "Let everyone be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established."

Prayer Focus: Pray for safety, wisdom, and integrity for law enforcement officers, and for justice and peace in the community.

6. Klehm Arboretum & Botanic Garden

Landmark: Klehm Arboretum & Botanic Garden

Scripture: Genesis 2:9 - "The Lord God made all kinds of trees grow out of the ground—trees that were pleasing to the eye and good for food."

Prayer Focus: Praise for the natural beauty and diversity of plant life. Pray for environmental stewardship and appreciation of nature.

7. Rockford University

Landmark: Rockford University

Scripture: Psalm 119:66 - "Teach me knowledge and good judgment, for I trust your commands."

Prayer Focus: Pray for students, faculty, and staff, for the pursuit of knowledge, wisdom, and ethical leadership.

8. Rockford Rescue Mission

Landmark: Rockford Rescue Mission

Scripture: Matthew 25:35-36 - "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me."

Prayer Focus: Pray for the homeless, the hungry, and those in need. Pray for the mission's staff and volunteers, and for the transformation of lives.

9. Veterans Memorial Hall

Landmark: Veterans Memorial Hall

Scripture: Psalm 34:18 - "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit."

Prayer Focus: Pray for veterans, their families, and those currently serving in the military. Pray for healing, support, and recognition of their sacrifices.

10. Alpine Park

Landmark: Alpine Park

Scripture: Isaiah 55:12 - "You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands."

Prayer Focus: Conclude with prayers for joy, peace, and community well-being. Pray for recreational spaces that bring people together and promote health and happiness.

Conclusion:

Gathering for a final group prayer.

Closing prayer of thanksgiving and commitment to continue praying for the city.
